Sail Safe PONTOON BOAT SKIPPER PROGRAM STATEMENT

Sail Safe is Sailability Shorncliffe's accreditation program for sailing and motorboat skippers operating at Sailability Shorncliffe. It is a practical, commonsense program with a clear focus on sail competency and safety.

Pontoon Boat skippers will familiarise themselves with the Pontoon Boat, as well as the boating conditions and navigational requirements of Cabbage Tree Creek, Bramble Bay and surrounding waterways. Skippers are coached in procedures and protocols to safely operate the boat and ensure the safety of those onboard, on the pontoon and on the water.

The Sail Safe Pontoon Boat Skipper program requires the prospective skipper to already have a current Queensland Recreational Marine Driver Licence or equivalent before any coaching is commenced. Coaching and accreditation sign off to be conducted by an accredited and experienced Pontoon Boat skipper.

Ongoing coaching and support is provided to skippers to improve and practice knowledge and skills. Regular maintenance and training days also provide opportunities to review and practice procedures.
